INDUSTRY NEWS

What you need to know about shipping restricted and prohibited items

Do you know what items the USPS prohibits or restricts for mailing or shipping in the U.S. and internationally? While there are some hazardous items that the USPS prohibits outright, they will accept others in limited quantities – and these items may need special shipping manifests or other labeling/warnings or permissions from USPS or Department of Transportation before shipping. It's a good idea to be aware of rules about shipping hazardous items because attempting to mail a prohibited item may result in your package being refused, confiscated, or destroyed and could make you liable for Federal prosecution.

Publication 52

If you have questions about what you can and can't ship via USPS, [Publication 52, Hazardous, Restricted and Perishable Mail](#) can help provide information and guidance. Publication 52 details the standards for non-mailable articles and substances, as well as the specific conditions under which some of these items can be mailed to both domestic and international destinations.

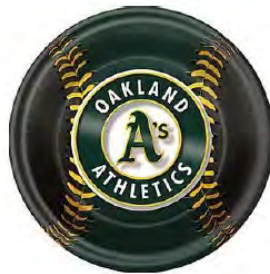
